Our 2013 Cabernet Sauvignon is dedication to Stan Clarke, renowned Washington State viticulturist, teacher and mentor of students of all ages. His favorite wine was Cabernet Sauvignon. Please enjoy this wine anytime, but especially in memory of Stan on its 10-year anniversary in 2023. The 2013 Cabernet Sauvignon is a blend from select vineyards in the Horse Heaven Hills including Destiny Ridge, Double Canyon and McKinley Springs Vineyards. Harvested in mid-October at 24.0 Brix, grapes were fermented separately in small open top fermenters for eight days. After light pressing, the lots were aged 26 months in French oak (50% new, five different coopers) before bottling in January 2016. With intense cherry, cassis, mocha and oak spice aromas and rich, full flavors, this wine can be enjoyed now or aged through 2025. 700 cases produced and released September 2016. 13.9% alcohol.
